

Virginia Pilot Among Missing Army Flyers

WILLIAMSBURG, (AP) — Mrs. W. A. R. Goodwin has been notified that her son, Second Lieutenant William A. R. Goodwin, Jr., 22, of the Army Air Forces, has been missing in action since August 9. He had served in the Sicilian campaign as a pursuit pilot.

The lieutenant's father, Dr. Goodwin, was rector of Bruton Parish Episcopal Church here for many years before his death and was instrumental in bringing about the restoration of Colonial Williamsburg.

The younger Goodwin graduated from Episcopal High School at Alexandria in 1940. He resigned from the University of Virginia as a sophomore to enter the Army Air Forces, and trained at Maxwell and Spence Fields before taking advanced training. He was sent to North Africa in May, this year.

A brother, Howard Goodwin, is now training with the Army Air Forces.
